Ontario Secondary School Diploma

All students in the province of Ontario are required to remain in secondary school until they have reached the age of 18 or obtained an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). To be granted an Ontario Secondary School Diploma, students must:

- earn 18 compulsory credits;
- earn 12 optional credits (minimum);
- complete 40 hours of community involvement activities;
- pass Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test.

A student will earn one credit for each 110-hour course successfully completed. A minimum of 12 optional credits will be earned in courses of the student's choice, reflecting particular interests and goals.

Compulsory Credits (18)

- 4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)
- 3 credits in Math (1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
- 2 credits in Science
- 1 credit in Canadian History
- 1 credit in Canadian Geography
- 1 credit in the Arts
- 1 credit in Health and Physical Education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- ½ credit in Civics
- ½ credit in Career Studies

Optional Credits (12)

In addition to the compulsory credits, students must complete:

- 12 optional credits†
- 40 hours of community involvement activities
- the provincial literacy requirement
